Kids Action Teams will be developed	600	Pupils have self-selected which action team they wish to be part of and impact on the school positively. Pupil leadership skills have been developed and used within the school and local community.
Post 16 pupils will run at least 5 differing enterprise schemes throughout the year, with some running continuously	500	Enterprise skills are central to Post 16 learning Pupils will continue to develop their enterprise skills and attributes .
Off-site visits	500	Pupils have benefitted from attending the Duke of Edinburgh Bronze award residential trip – gaining knowledge and an understanding of independent living skills. The surfing trip in Cornwall enabled pupils to experience being in the ocean and learn new water skills. Self confidence and self esteem levels have been increased.
Magdalen Farm	£8,979	Weekly visits to the farm have developed self-esteem and confidence in working in the natural environment, trying new activities and team working.
Riding	£3,500	Blocks of lessons for riding that developed skill, empathy, fitness and enjoyment.
EST – (emotional support time)	£3,600	Continuing weekly, and where needed, daily EST sessions provided to students on a 1:1 basis ensuring that pupils' emotional wellbeing and resilience are supported and developed.
Free School Milk	£150	Pupils where needed, will have a healthy drink
